Terms and condition for Orbix AI Competition 2023

1. Introduction

- 1.1. These rules apply to all competitions.
- 1.2. To enter a competition, you must register and provide necessary information.
- 1.3. The competitions are charged at a rate specified in the entry form.
- 1.4. The information provided by the contestant will be used for the purpose of the intended activity or related function, in conjunction with Orbix Education Group PDPA Statement. In accordance with Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) of Malaysia uses information provided by students, parents and individuals who are in contact with us for the purposes of the intended activity or related functions.

2. Competition format

- 2.1. There will be four categories of competition
 - 2.1.1. Primary School Coding Category
 - 2.1.2. Primary School Robotics Category
 - 2.1.3. Secondary School Coding Category
 - 2.1.4. Secondary School Robotics Category
- 2.2. Each category would have 2 levels of competition.
 - 2.2.1. School Level
 - 2.2.1.1. Competition will be conducted at respective schools.
 - 2.2.1.2. 3 winners of each category from each school will qualify to the Inter School level

2.2.2. Inter School Level

- 2.2.2.1. Competitions will be conducted at Orbix International School Batu Pahat (BPIS).
- 2.2.2.2. Participant will be provided lodging at SENTA Adventure Camp (SAC)
- 2.3. For each category, at each level, contestants would be given a set of instructions and devices to complete to task within the set time. The completed task would be judged based on the criteria set by the Panel of Judges.
- 2.4. Winners are selected based on criteria specified by the panel of judges. The criteria would be made known to the contestant before the competition starts.
- 2.5. If a contestant does not meet the eligibility requirements or is subject to any entry restrictions, that contestant shall not be entitled to be adjudged a winner.
- 2.6. The judge's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 2.7. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by Malaysia law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Malaysia.
- 2.8. The organizer reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of our control. Any changes to the competition will be notified to contestant as soon as possible by us.

2.9. Entry into the competition will be deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

3. Eligibility and entry restrictions

- 3.1. To be eligible to enter a competition:
 - 3.1.1. Contestants must be students at Orbix International School.
 - 3.1.2. Contestants who attend Primary school are only allowed to participate in Primary School competition, either coding or robotics or both.
 - 3.1.3. Contestants who attend Secondary school are only allowed to participate in Secondary School competition, either coding or robotics or both.
 - 3.1.4. Contestants must not be our employee, officer or agent, or an employee, officer or agent of any person or organization involved in the running of the competition and must not be a family relation of any such person.
 - 3.1.5. Contestants must register in the Entry Registration Form (https://bit.ly/3ZRVRR1) before the closing date on 30 April 2023 to be eligible.
- 3.2. Once the registration is closed, no further entrants will be accepted.

4. Winners and prizes

- 4.1. Competition prizes for each competition shall be specified on our website and/or social media channels.
- 4.2. Prize winners will be announced, and the prizes will be given in the ceremony after the competition.
- 4.3. In the event the prizes were not given during the ceremony, the organizer would deliver the prizes within a reasonable time to the winner after the event.
- 4.4. The results of the competition will be announced on our website. The announcement may include the name and photograph, and prize details of each prize winner.
- 4.5. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered. The prizes are not transferable.
- 4.6. Prizes are subject to availability, and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
